

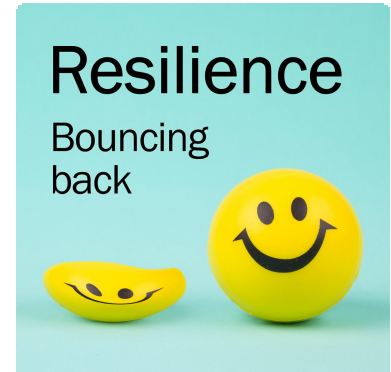
Week 11 update
