From the School Board: Likely Strike on Thursday, October 23rd

You may have seen in the news that educators across Aotearoa are preparing for potential **national strike action on Thursday, October 23rd**.

Please note: the strike notice has not yet been issued.

This potential action includes teachers, support staff, and Ministry specialists standing together to call for the vital investment needed in our education system.

This action is about more than just pay. Educators are taking this necessary step to secure:

- **Better Resourcing:** Ensuring our tamariki have the resources and support (like teacher aides in every classroom) they need to thrive.
- **Fair Value:** Upholding Te Tiriti o Waitangi in education and fairly valuing and offering secure work to all educators.

We understand this potential action causes disruption, but it reflects the seriousness of the challenges facing education and the urgent need for change to properly support our communities.

- We cannot guarantee adequate supervision for students on this day.
- We encourage all families to prepare to make alternative care arrangements for your children now.
